OPEN BURNING GUIDELINES

The following circumstances are the only allowable situations when burning is legal by the Ohio EPA and the Ohio Fire Code.

ALL LEGAL BURNING SHALL BE CONSTANTLY ATTENDED UNTIL FIRE IS EXTINGUISHED

Recreational fires are allowed if the fuel area is less than 3 feet in diameter and less than 2 feet in height.

Fires must use CLEAN SEASONED wood or clean burning fuels (i.e. natural gas or propane) ONLY.

Fires shall not be used to dispose of household waste (ex. Leaves, trash, brush, or other unwanted waste).

Must have an adequate fire-extinguishing agent immediately available (ex. Water hose, fire extinguisher, sand).

Must be 25 feet from any structure or can be as close as 15 feet from a structure in an approved fire container.

Open Burning that is offensive or objectionable because of smoke or odor or creates an undue fire hazard shall be prohibited.
